

Besides our ministry with baseball players and their families, Luis is involved with our pastor, David, in the International Human Rights Commission. Following his work as a pastor, his passion is in this area. He encouraged Luis to take the training, and now Luis is certified to go on his own or with our pastor, to visit prisons, work with the police department, among other areas of need to curtail delinquency in our province. It gives us an opportunity to share Christ with the officials, to pray with them and encourage them in sometimes a challenging position. Our pastor and Luis work especially closely with the general of the police department. His job includes four of our provinces that make up a population of 600 thousand.

The pictures below tell a story of some of their work. We had a visitor from Austin, Texas, who came to spend several days to minister or help us in any way. He was a blessing, not only to us, but to several groups that he met and was part of. He came with a fine message for each group, as well as his personal journey with the Lord.

Below, the first picture is of one of the trainers we work with who leads a league of 200 ball players. Next is Luis, our guest from Austin, and one the trainer's boys who was just signed to go to the U.S. to begin in one of the minor leagues.



The next picture is one of our bi-monthly meetings with the police where we are given the freedom to have a Bible study or message, music, and prayer with them.



The bottom picture on the left is the high security prison that our pastor with Luis visit to make sure that the inmates are being treated as the law requires, including food and fair management, in spite of whatever felony they have committed.

The last picture is us with the General of the Police for the four provinces. We go to pray with him, and visit, in his highly stressful job. He has recently come to Christ.
